



A New Direction for the Library

Accomplishments

Cardholders can checkout admission passes to LaunchPAD Children's Museum, Blank Park Zoo, and Greater Des Moines Botanical Gardens. Passes are available free of charge to cardholders and paid for by city and county tax dollars, saving on average \$27.50 per visit for a family of 4.

On August 21, 2017 the entire US had an opportunity to experience the Eclipse Across America. Ida Grove library offered free eclipse viewing glasses and held 7 programs leading up to the eclipse. We gave out 1,000 eclipse glasses, 686 attended the viewing party, and Ida Grove shared a spectacular solar event together.

The Ida Grove community was invited to participate in the library's strategic planning process. Twenty-three citizens attended focus groups to share input regarding our community and it's needs. From these focus groups, the library has created a community-centered strategic plan to guide library services and access to resources for the next three years.
